PE and Sport Premium Funding

The allocation for 2015-2016 = £8,390 and is being used in the following ways:

1. Accessing the Basic and Enhanced Service Level Agreements provided by Sedgefield School Sport Partnership:

Basic SLA (£1,150)

- A full organised annual programme of sports events in addition to the National School Games - 25 festivals, 4 after school leagues, Primary Olympics.
- Participation, inclusion and excellence opportunities opportunities for all abilities.
- Provision of after school sports club 6 week/half term club per year
- Provision of coaching support (curriculum/after school) 6 week/half term block per year
- Provision of one-off sport taster sessions Minimum 3 per school
- SSP Networking Meetings and Headteacher Meeting 2 days minimum
- Promotion and development of links to local sports clubs 15 potential school club links.
- Change for Life programme and School Games Mark additional support
- PE and School Sport Apprentice co-ordination and support.
- SSP Branding SSP Member School Logo, SSP supplement for school prospectus/website/newsletter.
- Additional funding opportunities, programmes and resources as available through new initiatives
- Central co-ordination of school sport programmes in the SSP including liaison with existing and new partners and initiatives on behalf of schools

Enhanced SLA (£4,000)

- High Quality Coaching coaches will be sourced, vetted and supplied by Sedgefield School Sport Partnership. Coaching will be provided for curriculum areas of Dance, Gymnastics, Athletics and Games. The SSP will provide a service of quality assurance and monitoring of coaches deployed. As advised by the government these coaches will work alongside teachers to provide professional development and will not cover PPA time. Schools will receive the coaching in the equivalent of 5 or 10 week blocks of 2 hours in the same time slot for the academic year.
- PE Teaching Support Sedgefield SSP will co-ordinate qualified teachers to support schools in teaching High Quality Curriculum PE. The support hours will include team teaching, curriculum planning support, whole school CPD sessions and transition activities to meet our school's needs.

- Menu of CPD Sedgefield SSP will provide a calendar of training opportunities to support curriculum PE delivery, linked to the National Curriculum and delivered by experienced tutors.
- Data Analysis and Reports Sedgefield SSP will provide a written report for schools to evidence the impact of the Sport Premium. The report would be suitable for OFSTED, Governors and to support your SEF. This report will be sent to schools at the end of the academic year but could also be produced at short notice for an OFSTED inspection.
- Links to NGBs/Community Clubs Sedgefield SSP will ensure that any
 coaching schools receive will link with wider opportunities in the community for
 young people to continue their involvement in sport. Coaching, where possible,
 will also link to Sedgefield SSP festivals and competitions.
- Gifted and Talented Identification Through the sport coaches and teaching support Sedgefield SSP will support schools to identify pupils who are gifted and talented in PE.
