The allocation for $2015-2016 = \pounds 51,780$ and is being used in the following ways:

- Additional teacher to support smaller class sizes in KS1 and KS2 and deliver a range of intervention groups.
- New iPads to further develop our children's computing skills across the curriculum.
- Subscriptions to the following Pearson online resources: Abacus (mathematics), Wordsmith (English), Bug Club (reading), Phonics Bug (Phonics for EYFS and KS1), and Grammar and Spelling Bug
- A range of support programmes to improve our children's social interaction and academic engagement and also increase parental involvement.
- Accessing the services of an Educational Psychologist via a local cluster agreement.
- Providing additional resources to assist with the delivery of the new primary curriculum.
- Subsidising educational visits and having theme days/weeks to give our children more first-hand experiences in order to enrich their learning.
- Paying for transport to and from sporting events throughout the year.
- Contributing towards the cost of employing a PE and School Sport Apprentice to support the delivery of PE and School Sport.
- Providing free or subsidised after school clubs to give our children the opportunity to experience good quality extra-curricular provision.
- Revision materials for our Y6 children to support them further in their preparations for end of key stage assessments.
- Subscription to our pupil tracking system to monitor the attainment and progress of all our children more carefully as well as help us to show that our 'Ever 6 FSM' children are achieving at least as well as our other children.
- Providing free small group instrumental tuition for children currently eligible for free school meals.
