For your final art task at home you can choose any of the following ideas below. I'd like you to have some fun with this!

You can either:

- Spend some time looking at the illustrations in the book. See if you can recreate any of them using a black pen.
- Using character of Kensuke as a source of inspiration look at using pen and inks to complete careful drawings of both natural objects and Japanese lettering.

- Create a line drawing of natural objects: mountains, fish, trees.
- Kensuke paints on items that he finds around the island and creates his own dyes from natural materials. Have a go at 'upcycling' an item from your house and if you are feeling really creative, see if you can create your own natural dyes (with permission of course!)
- You could paint a picture of a chosen area of the island in detail. An extra challenge would be to make your own paints using $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of flour, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of salt and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water. You could divide this into three sandwich bags and add food colouring to each. For more colours repeat the steps.
- Use natural materials to create an image of your choice. An example is shown below using sticks from a garden.
