Our topic for this half term is Let's go on an adventure

Literacy

We are continuing to practise our letter sounds and we will be recapping the digraphs e.g. ee, ai, igh etc to ensure the children can recognise and write them. We will be working secure the to correct formation of the letters a-z. We will begin to use a capital letter at the start of a sentence.

Through this topic our writing focus will be on writing simple stories. Miss Morgan has found lots of adventure stories to read to us and we will use these to help us create our own stories.
