Our topic for this half term is
Let's go on an adventure

Literacy

We are continuing to practise our letter sounds and we will be recapping the digraphs e.g. ee, ai, igh etc to ensure the children can recognise and write them. We will be working to secure the correct formation of the letters a-z. We will begin to use a capital letter at the start of a sentence.

Through this topic our writing focus will be on writing simple stories. Miss Morgan has found lots of adventure stories to read to us and we will use these to help us create our own stories.

Communication and Language

To ask and answer how or why questions.

Understanding the world

Find out about different places and look at the differences and similarities between them.

We will explore making maps and investigate the different ways we could travel to each place.

We will be finding out about directions and using the beebots to explore and follow simple routes.

Creative

This term we will be looking at our painting and drawing skills including colour mixing and adding more detail to our pictures.

Maths

Our focus this term will be on using and applying skills including adding and taking away numbers. We will investigate doubling and halving numbers and sharing small amounts. We will continue to develop our maths facts and investigate finding different ways to make numbers up to 10. We will build on our counting skills and recognition of numbers to 20.

Physical Development

During our PE lessons we will build on our ball skills including kicking, passing and aiming the ball to hit a target.
