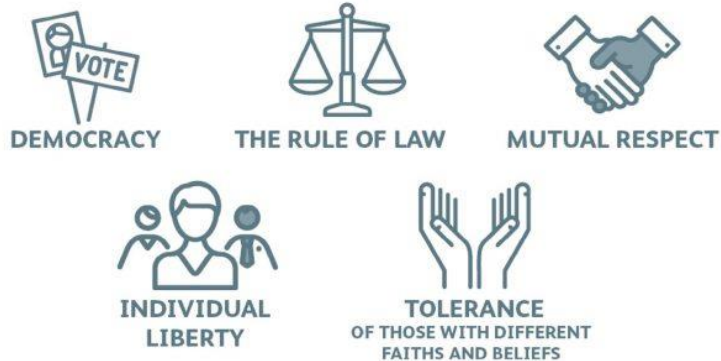


Spring 2 Assembly Themes 2023 -2024
