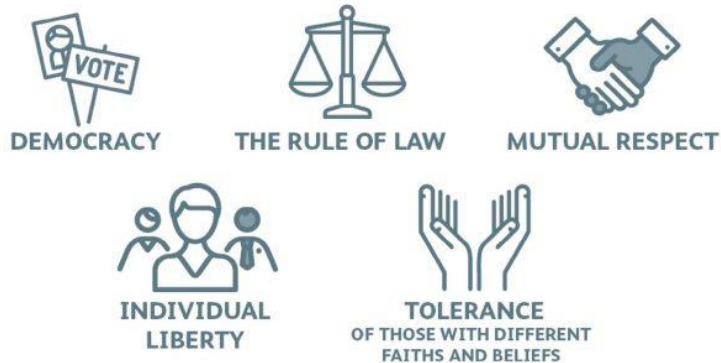


# Summer 1 Assembly Themes 2023 -2024
