Stalls will be available with things to buy. The class 4 ambassadors will be designing a leaflet to send out to advertise what will be on sale.

We will bring the children to the field at 1:30 and they will stay in their classes in a segregated area. Once your child's slot is finished, class teachers will sign the children out and hand them over to you, where they can enjoy watching their peers and having a picnic with their family. Please support us in keeping all of our children safe and ensure they are checked out by the teacher. Please then keep your child with you at all times once we have handed them over to you. You are welcome to leave after the run or welcome to stay until the end.
